

Aiming to Glorify God

Table Talk: Use the suggestions on the next page for this activity. Make a list of what salt does and what light does. What can you add to the list?

Prayer: Think of people who have been extra loving, extra present, extra helpful to you. Thank God for them and pray that God helps you to be like Jesus to others.

Read: Grab your Bibles and turn to the scripture for the day. Use Mr. Popcorn to allow children to read these verses. Then have an adult read as they close their eyes and listen. Move on to questions...

Ask:

- 1 What words or ideas stood out to you in these verses?
- 2 What do you think it means to be salt; what do you think it means to be light?
- 3 How might we lose our saltiness or try to hide our light? Examples.
- 4 God's goodness shines through the way we love others. Name times you've been salt and light.
- 5 Look at verses 14-15. When you are filled with God's Holy Spirit, can you hide it?

Only draw pictures that represent **LIGHT**, so you will remember our lesson today.
