

Growth: Modeling

Table Talk: You listed some people last week, that model Christ to you. How do they do that? What things stand out to you? How would you like to be more like them?

Prayer: Prepare yourselves and your space for prayer. Go to God in silence. Afterward, write down the things that came to mind. Tuck them into the wall.

Read: Get Bibles. Have a child read the scripture slowly as everyone listens and writes ONE word that stands out to them. Repeat two more times, using different readers each time.

Ask:

- 1 What three words stood out to you and why?
- 2 When you hear v.7a, what comes to mind? (social media, you have to do _?_ to be cool, etc.)
- 3 How can we train ourselves in godliness?
- 4 What keeps us from sharing our faith boldly?
- 5 How might we model godliness in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity?

Write a thank-you to someone who has modeled Christ to you.
